Location

Lake Dyer, Laidley (approximately 85km or 1hour from Brisbane CBD, 100km or 1hour 15mins from Brisbane Airport). Lake Dyer is also known as The Bill Gunn Dam and is situated in the beautiful Lockyer Valley between the villages/townships of Laidley and Forest Hill and is just a short detour off the Warrego Highway. Lake Dyer is 2km from the main street of Laidley (Patrick Street) - go along Patrick street and soon after the Queensland National Hotel (which will be on your left, cross the bridge and then turn right onto Gatton - Laidley Road). The entrance to Lake Dyer will be on your left.

Entries

Entries must be on APBA QLD Council Entry form (please see last page) and **MUST be completed correctly & have entry fee attached to be accepted**. Please send these to Gold Coast Powerboat and Sports Club, **Attention: Susan Lewis, P.O. Box 101, CORINDA, QLD 4075**. Full or provisional licenses for correct class of boat are required for this meeting. Full licenses are required to compete in the Major trophy races. APBA licence or authorisation, State Boating Authority License, proof of membership of APBA affiliated club & current boat registration **must be presented to officials at scrutineering** on Friday 28th June or Saturday 29th June 2013. NOTE: All documentation must be original - statutory declarations will not be accepted.

Entries must be received by Friday 14th June 2013.

Entry fee of \$100 (\$40 for formula future entrants) must be received with entry for it to be considered valid. **AS THIS EVENT IS RUN IN CONJUNCTION WITH AUSTRALIAN STREET ROD FEDERATION (ASRF), YOUR ENTRY FEE HAS BEEN SET AT \$100 (\$40 FOR FORMULA FUTURE) FOR THE 2 DAY EVENT. THIS HAS BEEN SUBSIDIZED TO YOU, AS ALL BOAT RACERS, CREWS, FOOD VENDORS, SPONSORS, CAR DISPLAY PARTICIPANTS, SPECTATORS AND ORGANISERS MUST PAY THE ENTRY FEE STIPULATED AT POINT OF ENTRY.** There are **NO** exceptions. Boat racers and crews staying at Lake Dyer Caravan and Camping Ground are asked to voluntarily pay their entry fees at arrival with their camping fees or they will be asked for entry fees by Susan Lewis on Friday afternoon or Saturday morning.

Entry fees

Saturday - \$5 per Adult, \$2 per child (10 - 17) Under 10 Free

Sunday - \$10 per Adult, \$2 per child (10 - 17) Under 10 Free

Pit Passes

These will be handed out at scrutineering or at the pit gate (when requested). These passes do not give you entry into the event, they only give you entry into the pits.

Scrutineering

Scrutineering will be held in the pits at Lake Dyer on Friday from 9am to 5pm and additional scrutineering will be available on Saturday 29th June between 7am and 10am.



Fuel

Fuel will be able to be purchased on site. Further details (eg. Pricing) will be released closer to the event.

Driver's Briefing

Briefings will be held on Saturday 29th June at 10.00am and Sunday 30th June at 8.30am sharp. Attendance is compulsory for all drivers and a roll will be called. Non-attendance at briefing will result in driver not being able to compete in that day's racing. Circumstances that prevent drivers from attending briefing, must be communicated to the officials prior to Pit closure of 9am on Saturday and Sunday 7.30am sharp on that day. (Please understand that there are over 400 cars coming in on display on Sunday and we cannot have boats entering the venue while we are trying to park cars. Your assistance in this matter will be greatly appreciated. We apologise in advance for the inconvenience).

Breath Testing

Breath testing will be conducted immediately prior to the driver's briefing on official practice day & each day of competition. Random breath tests will be conducted throughout each day. All officials & any drivers participating in official practice must undergo a breath test. All drivers and officials must undergo a breath test and record a zero reading on each day of competition & when requested for random breath testing. If a positive reading is returned, that driver cannot compete at that day's racing. If the breath analysis equipment is considered faulty, Officials may afford a driver a second test or use other breath analysis equipment if available. Such a test is to be conducted within 10 (ten) minutes of the original test or the minimum recommended interval as given by the manufacturer of the equipment.

Pits

Pits close at 9.00am on Saturday and 7.30am on Sunday. No boats will be permitted to enter the pits after this time- without exception. There will be no smoking or lit barbeques allowed in the pits. **Full covered footwear must be worn at all times.**

Security

Boats can be left at the venue, as the venue gates are locked at the main entry each night by 6pm. You can also park your boat next to the caretakers house or alternatively please bring your boat and park it at 50 Thallon Road, Hatton Vale (approx. 15km to venue), Lewis residence, which has a space for a large number of boats.
